



VENUE INFORMATION

Riverlinks Eastbank comprises the Eastbank Auditorium, Recital spaces, Box Office, function rooms, Studio spaces and bar.

Location: 70 Welsford Street, Shepparton.

Parking: The best off-street parking is on the Goulburn River side of Eastbank, accessed from Marungi Street. The river-side or Marungi Street door is open for all performances and delivers patrons directly to the Riverlinks Box Office.



Riverlinks Westside is owned by the Department of Education and managed by Greater Shepparton City Council

Location: Echuca Road, Mooroopna.

Parking: Best parking can be found off Homewood Drive, to the rear of Westside (from Mooroopna, turn left into Homewood Drive before you pass Westside or turn right, after Westside, if coming from Echuca direction). There is also easy street parking on Echuca Road opposite the theatre.
